3	<p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p>I CAN change <i>buenos</i> to <i>buenas</i> when I should.</p> <p>I CAN use <i>me llamo</i> and <i>se llama</i>.</p> <p>I can use <i>el</i> or <i>la</i> for <i>the</i>.</p> <p>I CAN change a color word to match a noun.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Examples</p> <p><i>Buenos días</i> – good morning; <i>buenas tardes</i> – good afternoon</p> <p><i>Me llamo</i> ____ – my name is ____.</p> <p><i>Se llama</i> ____ – his/her name is ____.</p> <p><i>El gato es blanco</i> – the cat is white.</p> <p><i>La vaca es blanca</i> – the cow is white.</p>
4	<p style="text-align: center;">Vocabulary</p> <p>I CAN use greetings.</p>	<p><i>buenos días; buenas tardes; buenas noches</i> (good evening, night)</p> <p><i>hola</i> – hello</p> <p><i>adiós, ciao, hasta luego</i> – farewells</p>
	<p>I CAN describe the color of an object.</p>	<p>Colors: <i>rojo, anaranjado, morado, verde, negro, amarillo, azul, rosado, blanco, gris, café</i></p>
	<p>I CAN answer “How many?”</p>	<p>Numbers 1-15: <i>uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco, seis, siete, ocho, nueve, diez, once, doce, trece, catorce, quince</i></p>
5	<p style="text-align: center;">Culture/Craft</p> <p>I CAN color a flag of a country celebrating independence in September.</p>	<p>Hispanic Heritage month is Sept. 15- Oct. 15. Seven Latin American countries (Mexico, El Salvador, Guatemala, Costa Rica, Nicaragua, Honduras, and Chile) celebrate their independence during this time.</p>
