	I CAN talk about the weather.	<i>hace frío</i> – it’s cold; <i>hace calor</i> – it’s hot; <i>hace fresco</i> – it’s cool; <i>llueve</i> – it’s raining; <i>hace sol</i> – it’s sunny; <i>está nublado</i> – it’s cloudy; <i>hace buen/mal tiempo</i> – it’s good bad/weather; <i>hace viento</i> – it’s windy; <i>nieva</i> – it’s snowing
5	Culture/Craft I CAN help make a <i>cascarón</i> , a Mexican confetti Easter egg.	Easter week is a very important and sacred time for most Latin American families.
